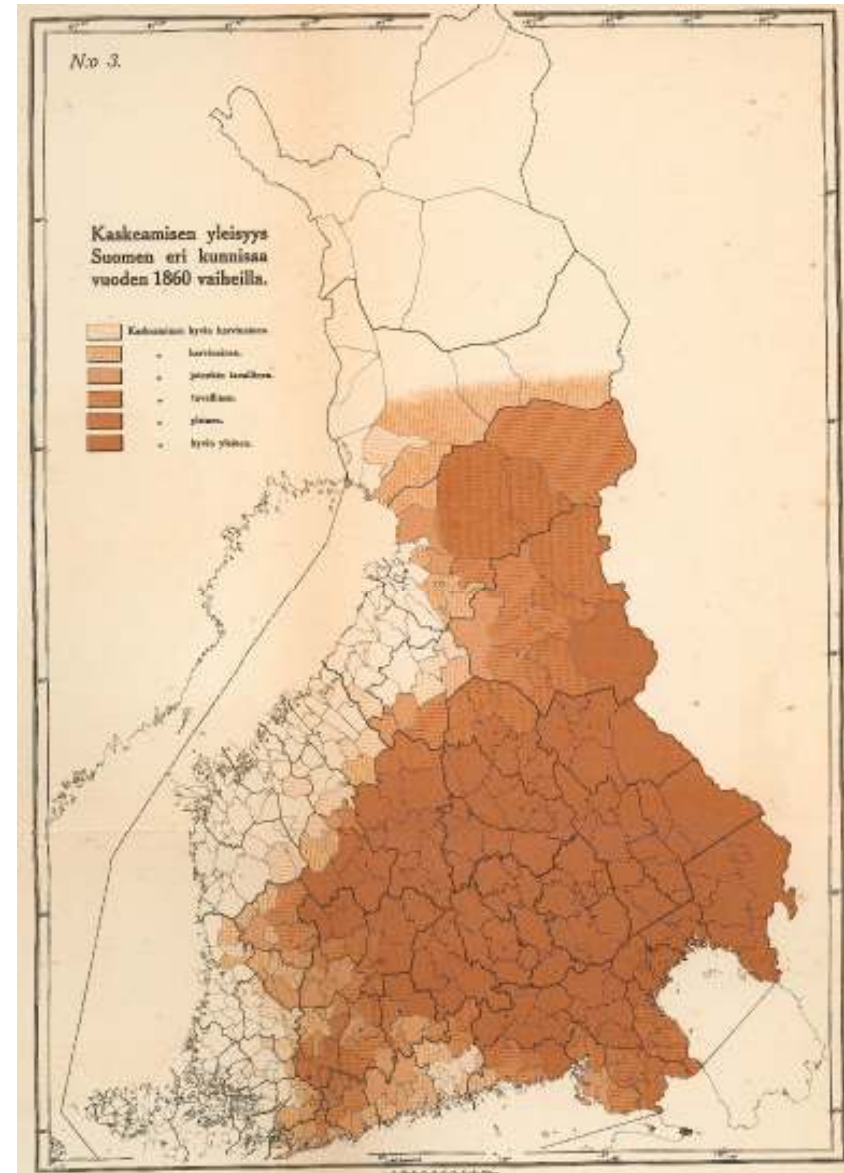

Spreading of slash and burn cultivation in Finland in 1860-ies



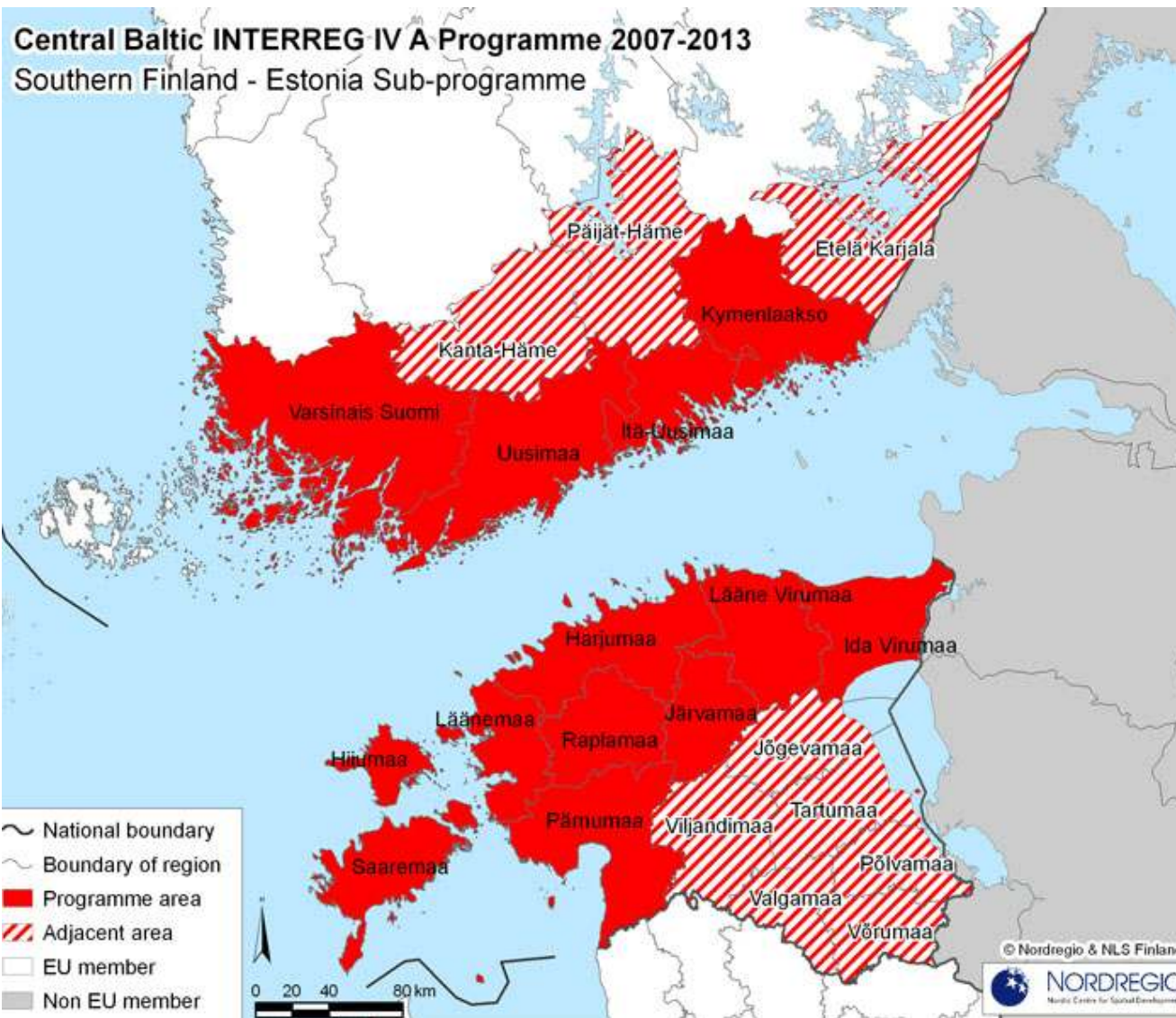

Quantitative targets

- People involved in information days, trainings, fieldtrips, seminars, 2 180 participants
- Cultural heritage mapped in
Estonia 850 000 ha
Finland 33 000 ha privately owned commercial forests
- Amount of publications, booklets, etc. 18 900 copies



Qualitative targets

- Public and target groups awareness of cultural heritage and its importance of the protection grow
- Cultural heritage mapping in Estonia and Finland using common methodology
- Decreased risk of cultural heritage destruction
- Database in public use and increased awareness

Output indications

- 8 new co-operations established
- 6 further developed co-operations
- 150 organisations involved in co-operations: One organisation can be counted several times if the co-operations are different



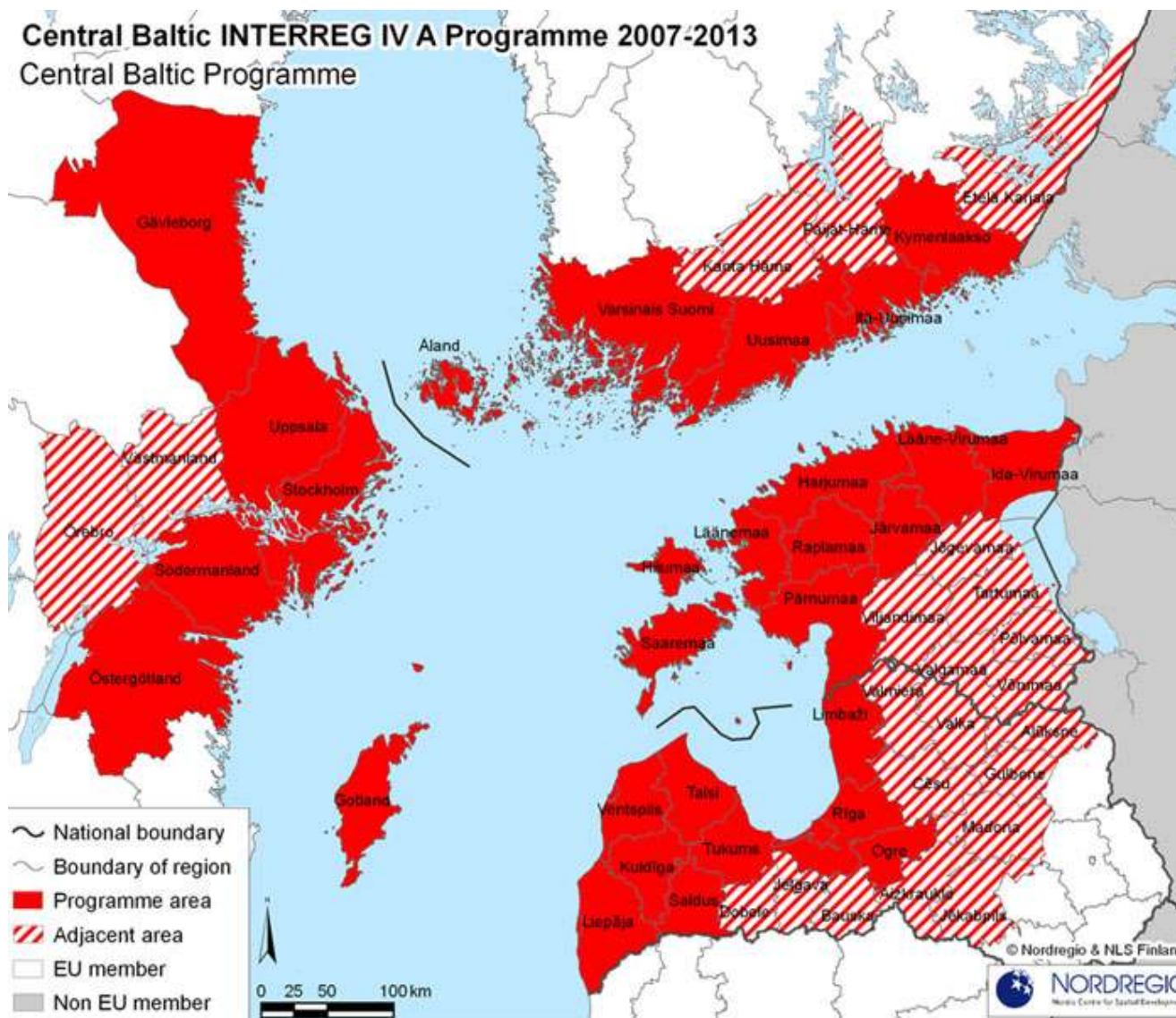
Result indications
